

Notes for Parish meeting July 2014

Thank you to all involved in the delivering, the picking up, many times to the same locations and the collection so far sits at 223 in my study, others to be collected from the collectors should take us to around 13-15% returns. Good, well compared to business marketing questionnaires, very good they typically come in at 2-3% compared with others, OK...

What next,

Well Paul and I have already replied to the person we are working with in the county to get the next part of the NDP process. Our plan needs to ensure that it doesn't have any adverse impact upon protected wildlife or species and Special Areas of Conservation, and to meet the requirements of the European Legislation. As part of this process an initial screening report was undertaken. This then showed that we need to process to the next stage of undertaking a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) and Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA).

The first stage of this process is to undertake a 'Scoping Report'

This scoping report was reviewed by Paul and myself. I passed our comments to our planner and it is now off for a 5 week Statutory consultation with the Environment Agency, Natural England and English Heritage.

Once this stage has been completed.

The planner needs to assess our objectives, options and ultimately our policies against the SEA objectives to ensure there will be no adverse impact on the environment from your proposals. That takes about 4 weeks once we have produced our documentation.

So next to pull the results together from the questionnaires, have steering meeting and discuss the creation of the draft plan that has to be shared with country before the public review in late September/early October as mentioned before.

To recap had our 6 sessions held in January and February.

Preston Wynne had 26% of the Electoral role, Withington, a disaster. 3%. Westhide 27% of the Electoral roll.

The follow on session on the 29th March, 10:00 to 16:00, had just over 100.

The results of this day showed that a clear view about which locations.

69 % for the site that had the most votes.

Followed by 8% for the next 2 locations. 5% for the next one and so on.

That is on first choice.

If adding the 1, 2 and 3 choices together. Same site, still 3 times ahead of the next site.
